Architectural Metals Australia Privacy Policy

The website is owned and operated by Architectural Metals Australia (AMA) and will be referred to as “We”, “our” and “us” in this Internet Privacy Policy. By using this site, you agree to the Internet Privacy Policy of this web site (“the web site”), which is set out on this web site page. The Internet Privacy Policy relates to the collection and use of personal information you may supply to us through your conduct on the web site.

We reserve the right, at our discretion, to modify or remove portions of this Internet Privacy Policy at any time. This Internet Privacy Policy is in addition to any other terms and conditions applicable to the web site. We do not make any representations about third party web sites that may be linked to the web site.

We recognise the importance of protecting the privacy of information collected about visitors to our web site, in particular information that is capable of identifying an individual (“personal information”). This Internet Privacy Policy governs the manner in which your personal information, obtained through the web site, will be dealt with. This Internet Privacy Policy should be reviewed periodically so that you are updated on any changes. We welcome your comments and feedback.

What information do we collect?

Architectural Metals Australia collects the following information regarding visitors to this website; domain name, information regarding what pages are accessed, information volunteered by you, such as survey information, email address, site registrations and your preferred means of communication. This information is collected and logged for statistical and marketing purposes. Away from this website AMA collects information from its customers that includes; name, postal address, email address, contact phone numbers, business name and sales records. This information is collected and logged for commerce and statistical purposes and may be used to contact you.

Personal Information

Personal information about visitors to our site is collected only when knowingly and voluntarily submitted. For example, we may need to collect such information to provide you with further services or to answer or forward any requests or enquiries. It is our intention that this policy will protect your personal information from being dealt with in any way that is inconsistent with applicable privacy laws in Australia.

How is information collected and stored?

Information is collected by AMA by you volunteering the information through a form on this website or from a cookie. Through the use of a cookie, AMA can record the pages you visit and the information you require. Through analysis of these records, AMA can provide you with a website that is continually improving to meet your requirements. You can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, providing you with the opportunity to either accept or reject it. You can also refuse

all cookies by turning them off in your browser, however fully functional access to the site requires the use of cookies.

Information collected outside of this website is collected through you volunteering the information to AMA.

Disclosure

Apart from where you have consented or disclosure is necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was submitted, personal information may be disclosed in special situations where we have reason to believe that doing so is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against anyone damaging, injuring, or interfering (intentionally or unintentionally) with our rights or property, users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. Also, we may disclose personal information when we believe in good faith that the law requires disclosure.

We may engage third parties to provide you with goods and services on our behalf. In that circumstance, we may disclose your personal information to those third parties in order to meet your request for goods or services.

How can I access my information that AMA has stored?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer stored information to outside parties within Australia or Internationally. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business or servicing you. This also does not include legal authorities if in the case of an investigation or other legal matter. IP Addresses
